# A Vulnerable Neighbourhood

## McQuesten, Hamilton

The McQuesten neighbourhood is one of the more financially stretched areas in Hamilton, with many residents facing the daily challenges of poverty. The community includes a high number of single-parent households, and students often face barriers to learning that can make academic success more difficult to achieve.

After prayerfully surveying 21 neighbourhoods in 2018, Mercy Church felt a clear and compassionate call to be a gospel presence in this vibrant and resilient community.

# **We are a Reformed church in East Hamilton that glorifies God through gospel-centred worship, intentional discipleship, and the promotion of the gospel both locally and abroad.**

Mercy Church preaches the full council of God's Word while extensively reaching the McQueston neighbourhood.

- We walk alongside single mothers,
- advocate for youth caught in street life,
- assist with groceries and job connections,
- prepare welcome baskets for Indwell tenants, and
- host drop-in programs and a Moms & Tots group.

All of it is rooted in the desire to proclaim Christ not only in word, but in tangible acts of mercy and love.



## **Mercy Youth**

Mercy Youth ministers to groups of high schoolers every week.

## The Mercy Center

We rent a modest storefront, which we have called the Mercy Center. It is a hub for prayer, Bible study, pastoral care, and community outreach throughout the week.

This space has been a wonderful blessing to our church and the surrounding community, but our ministry is outgrowing it.

## Sports & Tutoring

Local children drop in every Tuesday for sports and tutoring.



# The Witness is Displaced.

Mercy Church had been renting a local Catholic Church for Sunday services in the McQuesten neighbourhood, but was displaced when this building suffered a significant basement flood. That building had its limitations - steep stairs, no nursery, unreliable elevator - but it had been a gift.

God provided Guido School as a meeting place which is only 3 km away, but for many in our neighbourhood without cars or mobility, it might as well be across the city. We've arranged rides, but the barrier is daunting. At our current size, renting space in McQuesten is challenging.



# God's Missional Heart.

Being thankful for God's work in our lives, we long to extend His grace to individuals and families in McQuesten. Our guiding Scripture is from Ephesians 2:

"But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ -

**by grace you have been saved"**

We prayerfully and intentionally share God's love in all of our ministries.



## **40** Children

Our Tuesday Drop-In sees up to 40 children each week for worship and a bible story, a meal, sports, and tutoring.

## **100** Participants

Our Summer Games Night impacts up to 100 children each week.

## **30** Teenagers

Mercy Youth ministers to 30 youth on a weekly basis.

We bless this neighbourhood with a Moms and Tots program, community-wide clean up, a Christmas flower drop for 1000 families and by volunteering at the McQuesten Urban Farm.



# God is at Work.

God has saved several neighbours in the six years we've been here, and we have introduced a multi-generational Bible Study with a number of women attending from the community and two evangelistic small groups meeting on different nights with between 25 – 35 people in attendance.

# A Message from Pastor Ian Wildeboer

Brothers and sisters, friends of Mercy,

From the start, we've always said that Mercy Church is not just about Sundays. It's about being present – right here – in the heart of McQuesten.

It's about living and proclaiming the mercy of God in a neighbourhood that is in great need for more faithful gospel witness.

We've seen the Lord do more than we asked or imagined. From a handful of families meeting in Sept of 2019 to over 300 people gathering weekly, from youth on the margins to women studying the Word around tables in the Mercy Centre, Christ is building His church. But we are at a crossroads.
